# Keep Clear Signage Tadmarton



"Keep Clear" signage has now been installed on both sides of the lane leading from Church Furlong and the Village Hall carpark.

The signage was installed as a request from Parishioners who expressed safety concerns when pulling out from the lane onto the main road. Their "sight lines" were being obscured by vehicles parking too close to the junction.

In addition, more personal space was needed for passengers, when they are getting on and disembarking from buses. It also, now, provides a clear and safe drop off and pick up area for the elderly and infirm and, let us not forget, it will also allow people to use the bench without being hindered by being too close to the side of a parked vehicle.

"Keep Clear" was installed by Oxfordshire County Council Highways and we would ask everyone to respect the signage and ensure the areas remain clear of all vehicles at all times.

This will ensure the safety and comfort of everyone.
