We have been out and about at Sibford Gower Endowed Primary School. The lifting of Covid restrictions has meant that we have been able to organise trips and visits again. These are occasions our pupils really enjoy and they provide wonderful opportunities to enrich the children's learning in ways which can be truly memorable.

Willow Class made a fairly local trip, but exciting nonetheless. They visited Swalcliffe Barn where they were able to explore, at first hand, a range of Roman artefacts that have been unearthed in the local area. This linked brilliantly with the learning that they have been doing in school and

illustrated the key message that there are traces of the past all around us if we look carefully.

The children in Oak Class went a bit further afield with their trip to the Banbury Museum. Oak Class have been learning all about the Victorians and the Industrial Revolution. The workshops they took part in as part of the trip deepened their understanding of the development and impact of the canal system and they learned all sorts of things about the lives of Victorian canal workers. They also went for a trip on a canal boat, making this a day that none of them will forget.

Amelia M: " We learned a lot about how important the canals were. A horse and cart can pull one tonne on the road but, using the canals, a horse can pull thirty tonnes because of the buoyancy."

Theo F: "We learned SO much! On the canals, instead of making tunnels or going around the hills, the locks are used to allow the canal boats to go up and down hills by using the lock gates to let water in and out."



Our younger children will be visiting the Cotswold Wildlife Park later this term. This will give the children in Acorn class the chance to actually see some of the animals they are currently exploring in their Around the World topic and understand, for instance, just how tall and elegant giraffe really are and that meerkats can be just as enchanting in real life as the animated ones are! Because of Covid, for many of the younger children it will be their very first experience of a school trip and how much fun these can be. All very exciting!

We offer excellent nursery provision for children aged 3+

Our Early Years provision continues to be really successful. We provide a calm, structured and supportive learning environment for children from 3+. The children are settled and happy and the learning outcomes for both nursery and Reception-aged children within the early years classroom are really strong. Although Reception is very nearly full for next year, we do still have nursery places. If you have a nursery-aged child and are considering a nursery place for them, you are more than welcome to contact the school to arrange a visit and a chat. Your child can join us at any time from the term after they are three and all 3 and 4 year olds are entitled to 15 funded hours of early education per week.

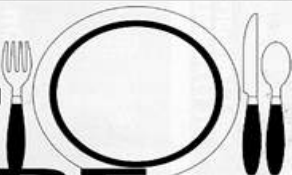

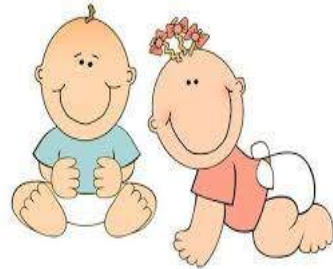

Dear friends,

I must go seek some dew-drops here
 And hang a pearl in every cowslip's ear.
 Farewell, ... spirits: I'll be gone;
 Our queen and all her elves come here anon.

These words spoken by one of Queen Titania's woodland fairies in Shakespeare's, *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, captures the beauty of a Summers morning, when we wake to find glistening early morning dew. Shakespeare's play, set as it is in the mythical world of fairies, places the Queen at it's very centre, at its beating heart, she is pivotal to what happens. Her impact upon the characters of the play is lifechanging, even when she herself is not actually present on stage. Queen Titania speaks and the world in which she lives changes around her.

As we celebrate Queen Elizabeth II's Platinum Jubilee, we might want to take time to reflect upon the enormous impact that she has had in her lifelong service both publicly and privately to our country, the Commonwealth and the World.

You may already be aware that our Queen holds the special title 'Defender of the Faith and Supreme Governor of the Church of England'. Now the Queen's Christian faith is known by many of us and she has referred to her Christian beliefs in each of her Christmas day messages. So however we might be giving thanks and celebrating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee, individually and together in our villages, let us give thanks to God for her and all that she has done and continues to do as Queen and as the Defender of the faith and Supreme Governor of the Church of England.

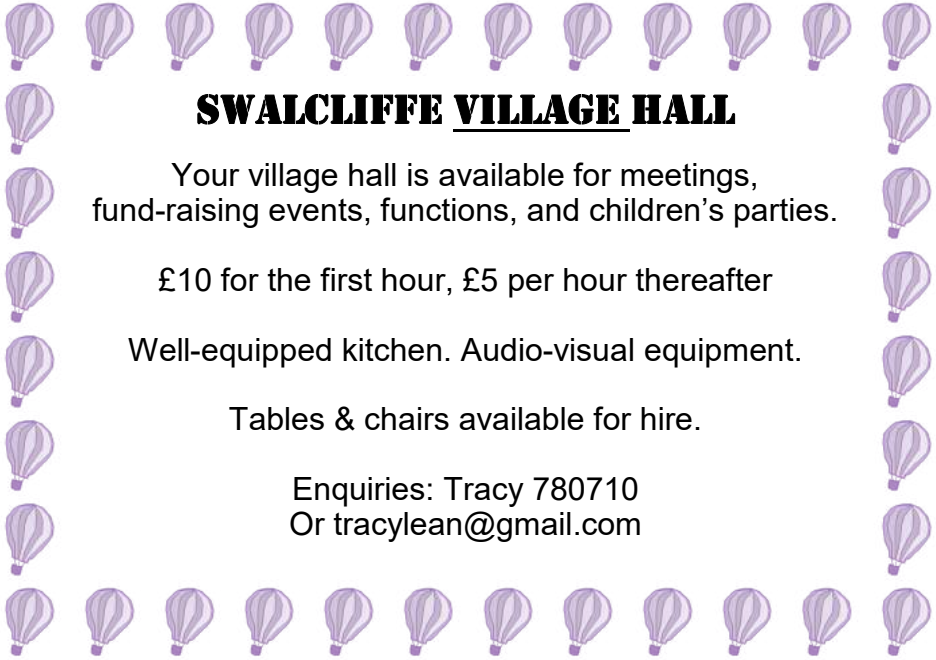

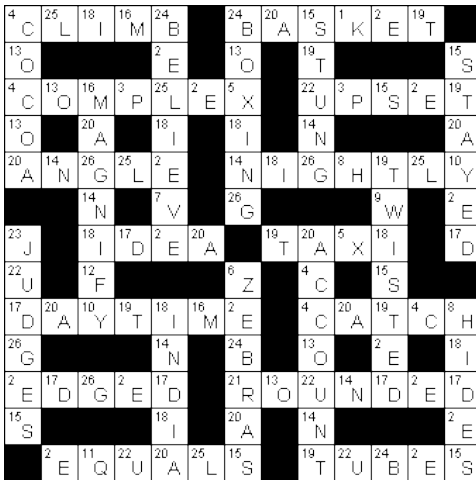

The Wildlife Page: ANTS

Grossly misunderstood, heavily condemned, killed by the millions, and yet one of the most valuable critters in your garden. (See paragraph 4)

So what are Ants? Ants are complex insects that live in large social groups called colonies. There are over 12000 known Ant species in the world. As insects, ants have a hard outer body called an exoskeleton and three body parts: head, thorax, and abdomen. They have no ears and some have no eyes. Communication happens with the use of Vibration, Antennae and Pheromones.

A single ant can carry 50 times its own bodyweight, and they'll even work together to move bigger objects as a group!

Ant communities are headed by a queen or queens, whose function in life is to lay thousands of eggs that will ensure the survival of the colony. Male ants often have only one role—mating with the queen. After they have performed this function, they may die. Flying Ants are “normal” male ants and Queens who are looking to create a new colony. The vast numbers seen are to give the queens a fighting chance, whilst birds help themselves to the rich pickings for their young. Workers -the ants typically seen by humans- are wingless females that never reproduce, but instead forage for food, care for the queen's offspring, work on the nest, protect the community, and perform many other duties, like keeping the nest clean of waste and the bodies of dead members as this is important for the health of all.

Ants feed mainly on fleas, caterpillars, termites, aphids, dead remains of insects and animals and honeydew, a sweet liquid excreted by aphids and other sap-eating insects.

They also eat the waxy material from the peony allowing them to fully bloom and to top it all you don't need an aerator if you have ants.

So you see these tiny insects really are incredible. That does not take away the fact that they can be a nuisance but there are ways to deal with Ants in an environmentally sustainable way, good for you and good for the Ants.

Ensure you keep your floor clean from foods that Ants like (Sweet sugar rich items, and dead bugs and insects), Hoover regularly to remove shedded human skin and mites.

Plant the following plants close to your house : Rosemary, Lavender, Peppermint, Thyme, Tansy and Catnip (Although this might attract feline visitors instead). Garlic as always is also known to be a deterrent (and it will even keep Dracula out)

I could go on forever. They truly are amazing insects, so check them out and allow yourself to be in awe.
